Baseline Assessments Autumn 1	Phonics, spelling, sight words, reading comprehension, punctuation and grammar Handwriting speed and letter formation Dyslexia screening Mathematics development screening
Phonics	Following the screening, learners with difficulties in reading will follow the Read Write Inc Fresh Start programme. This is a catch-up and intervention programme for learners Year 5 to Year 8 who are still learning to read. All learners with a reading below 10 years will also read to an adult for a minimum of 10 minutes daily.
Nurture	Our learners will be supported through structured activities in fostering relationships with their peers and teachers to develop their self-esteem and better understand and express their emotions.
